SUBMISSION CHECKLIST:

- 1) This completed nomination form (*please keep a copy for your files*).
- 2) Biography (two pages maximum) of the nominee.
- 3) One-to-five copyright-free photos of the nominee in JPEG, TIFF, or PDF format (350 dpi, full color photos preferred), on a CD-ROM, readable on PC and MAC.
- 4) Optional documentation (cds, dvds, related website addresses, press kit, and /or other materials).
- 5) A \$25.00 (US currency) check for processing / postage, payable to: The St. Joseph Music Foundation.

TIMELINE (CF. BRIEF OVERVIEW, BOTTOM RIGHT):

- Nominations are accepted from **May 1** to the **May 31** of the award year.
- Nomination applications are sent to voting members **June 7** and are returned to our office by **June 14**.
- All parties, press, *etc.*, will be notified of winners **October 1**.
- Public Award Ceremony is in November (dates and locations may vary). All parties / press will be notified. — Winners who are unable to attend will receive their citation, plaque, and other materials by **December 31** of the award year.
